iGroups

- iGroups are small groups on Wednesday nights.
- After the first hour of GZi, we transition to groups.
- Groups of 8-10 students are paired with an adult leader.
- Students listen to an encouraging message then have topic relevant conversation with their group and leader.
- Groups are separated male/female as well as middle school and high school.
- Group leaders are same sex as the group unless it is a husband/wife combo.
- All group leaders are trusted adults by GZ and have completed and passed a background check/all requirements.
- Photos/videos to be taken and used in publicity materials/social media

Joining an iGroup

- Students cannot join a group until they and their parent/guardian signs this form. We want students to be committed to this time together and want to respect the safe spaces these groups will create.

Expectations

- Attend iGroups each week
- Respect that iGroup is a “no cell phone” environment
- Don’t bring outside guests to group (anyone can sign up to be a part of iGroups, but they must go through the commitment process before joining)
- Respect the venue, the leaders, and each other
- Respect what others share in iGroups
- Attend iGroup outings/events
- If a student does not respect these expectations, they will be asked to take a break from the group, and the parent/guardian will be notified

iGroup Events

- iGroup exclusive events such as Out All Night or iGroup socials.
- iGroup activities run by the group leader outside of Monday and Wednesday nights. This could include the leader taking students to see a movie together, meeting up to play a sport together, heading to the beach together, etc.
